**K. Complaints Handled:**

- *Burnham vs. Kaplan University* – full refund to student.
- *Hoffman-Saeger vs. Kaplan University* – all tuition charges and financial aid amounts satisfactorily explained to student
- *Deans vs. Sanford-Brown College-Milwaukee* – student allowed to re-take some parts of training at no charge
- *Seneli vs. PC ProSchools, Inc.* - School sent check to student’s grandmother-in-law. No further action needed.
- *Grittner vs. Walden University* - student enrolled and financial aid restored.
- *Richmond vs. High-Tech Institute* - student’s charges written off and collection calls called off.
- *Yager vs. East-West Healing Arts Institute* - student’s prepaid tuition refunded by school.
- *Andrews vs. FYB (Feel Your Best) Yoga Teacher Training School* - Yoga Therapy not an EAB approved program. School stopped harassment and offered class again.
- *Sullivan vs. FYB (Feel Your Best) Yoga Teacher Training School* - issues with school are part of a civil suit. Outside of EAB’s authority.
- *Kempt vs. University of Phoenix* - EAB concurred with UoP that it provided appropriate guidance to student and charges remain valid. No further action needed.
- *Bell vs. New Horizons of Wisconsin* - school correctly charged student, returned correct amount to Sallie Mae, no refund is due to student.
