EAB Announces 2nd Quarter Administrative Actions

Madison – At its June 2006 meeting, the Educational Approval Board (EAB) approved the administrative actions of staff taken during the 2nd quarter of the year. Highlights include the approval of Le Cordon Bleu College of Culinary Arts that offers two applied science degrees, and the approval of 13 other programs that will now be offered by already approved schools. In addition, the EAB issued a cease and desist order to Binary Training, Inc. of De Pere, which was offering various IT programs without proper state approval, and resolved four student complaints.

The EAB currently oversees 142 schools serving approximately 30,000 adults in more than 600 degree and diploma programs.
