### **EAB Announces 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Administrative Actions**

Madison – At its September 2006 meeting, the Educational Approval Board (EAB) approved the administrative actions of staff taken during the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of the year. Highlights include the approval of three new schools – The Bar School (La Crosse), Synvent University (West Bend) and Liberty Tax Service (operating multiple state locations).
