EAB Announces 4th Quarter Administrative Actions

Madison – At its December 2007 meeting, the Educational Approval Board (EAB) approved the administrative actions of staff taken during the 4th quarter of the year. Highlights include the approval of five new schools – Motorcycle Technology Center, York, PA; Rinehart Taxidermy Institute, Janesville, WI; and, University of International Arts, Ltd., Racine, WI.
