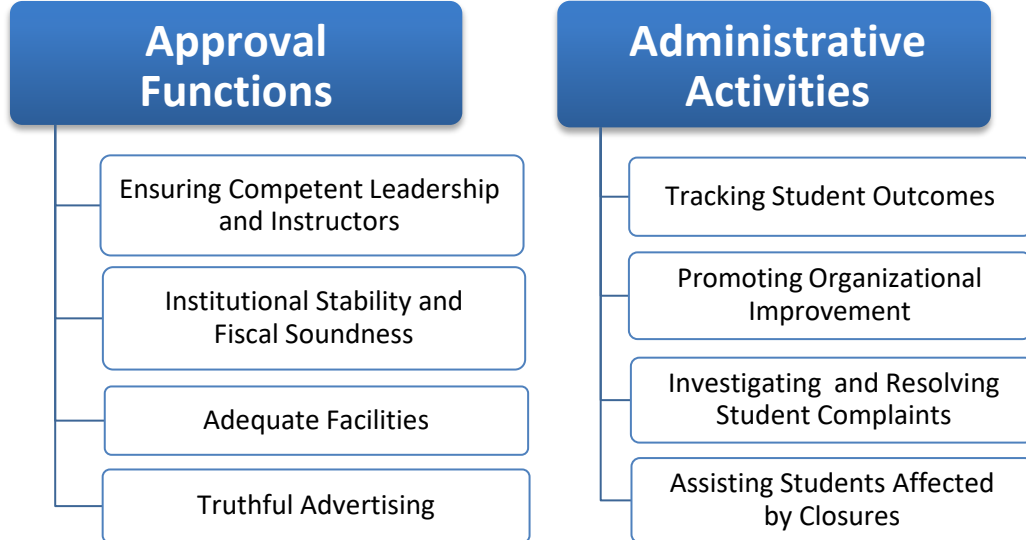

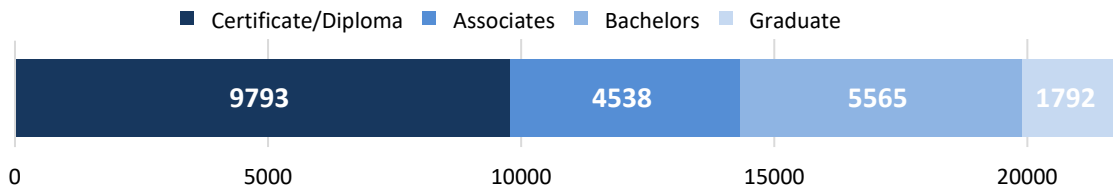

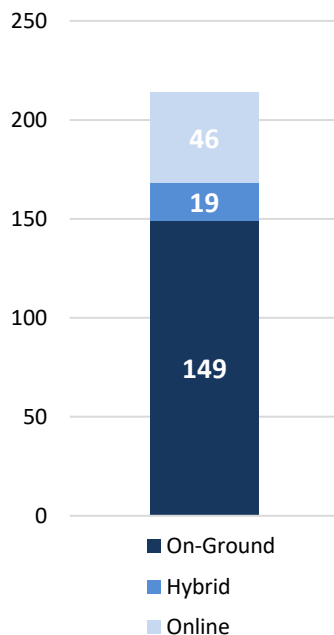


Students, Schools and Subjects in 2015

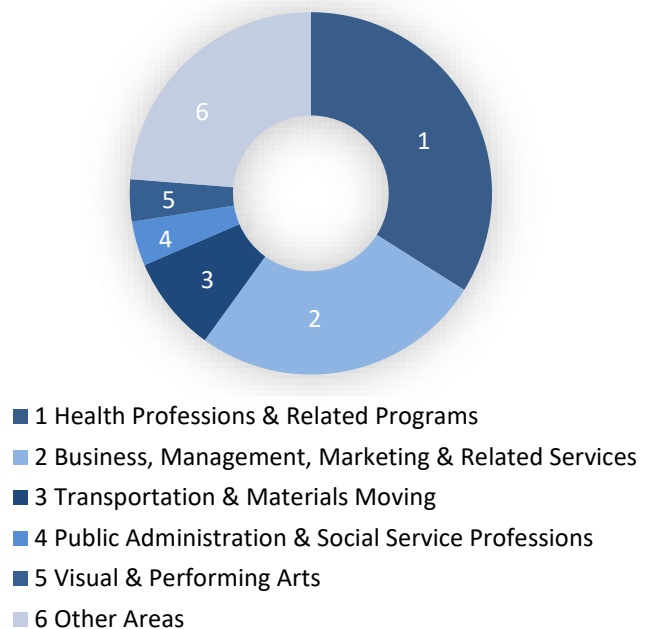
Total 2015 New Student Enrollment: 21,688 Students



School Types



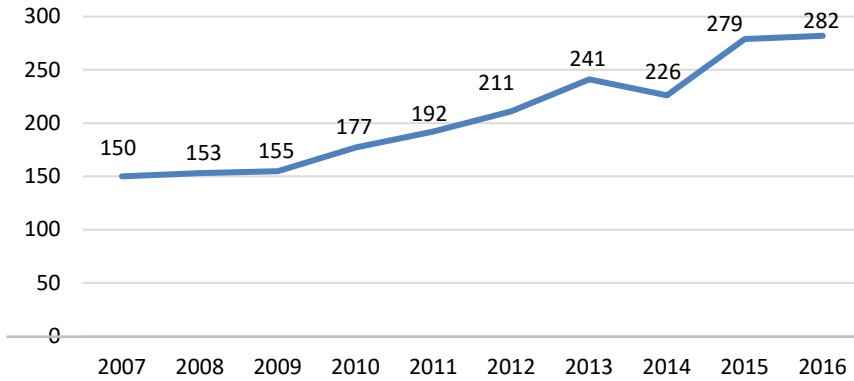
Demand by Subject Area



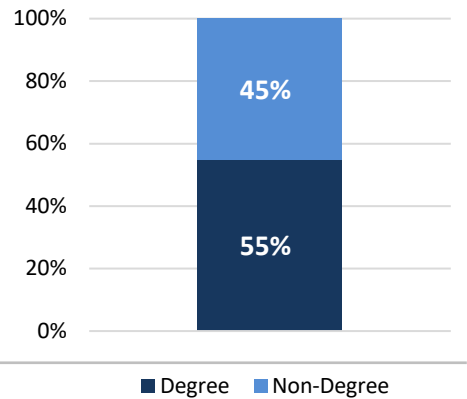

Note: figure includes schools that are now exempt by state reciprocity agreements



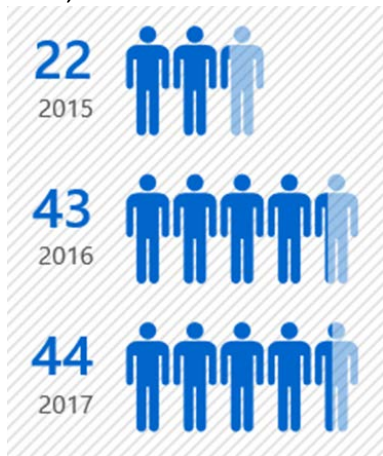
Enrollment by Program Type



How the EAB Helps Students

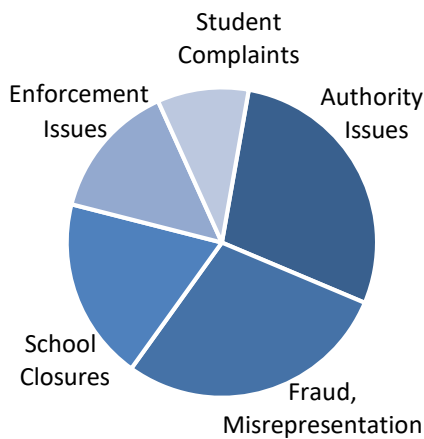
Complaints

EAB staff investigate student complaints about school policies, questionable practices, and refunds.*



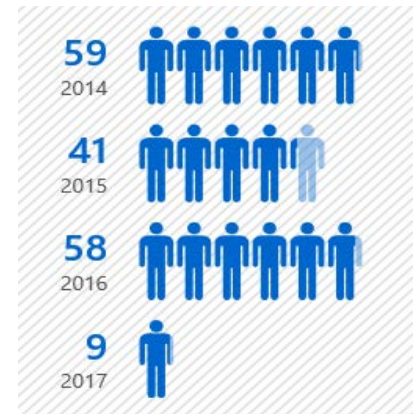
Enforcement
